Storm Safety

Got outdoor plans? Here are a few tips to help you stay safe as summer storms roll in:



If you can hear thunder, you are within striking distance of lightning. Look for shelter inside a home, large building, or a hard-topped vehicle right away.



Do not go under trees for shelter. There is no safe place outside during a storm.



Wait at least 30 minutes after hearing the last clap of thunder before leaving your shelter.



Stay away from windows and doors. Stay off porches. Places with only a roof on sports fields, golf courses, and picnic areas are NOT safe during a lightning storm. Small sheds should not be used.

If a person is struck by lightning, call 911 for medical help.
